## September 3 ~ PK Tessmann & Corwin Fox



PK Tessmann is a fixture in the Vancouver Island indie-folk community. Her well-crafted, original songs are something of substance: a synergy of flowing lyrics, whispered harmonies, twinkling ukulele or acoustic guitar, and her bold, multi-faceted voice. With over 20 years of songwriting and performance behind her, PK is celebrating the release of her brand new album *'Dear City'* (2016). Two-time winner of Best Roots/Folk Recording at the *Vancouver Island Music Awards*, PK's work has been described as "beguiling", "potent", and "unpretentious". Her latest work is no exception.

PK has performed extensively solo, however she

will be joined tonight by her producer, **Corwin Fox**—a Canadian songwriter, producer and multi-instrumentalist, who has toured extensively across Canada, the US, and Australia since 1995. Over the last decade, **Corwin** has been spending an increasing amount of time recording and producing other artists across a wide range of genres. He still plays concerts and festivals performing his songs on banjo, guitar, and ukulele, and he teaches songwriting to youth each summer. Continuing to write, record, and tour, **Corwin** is quite content that the bulk of his time is now spent in his studio or hanging out with his kids and making soup.

## September 10 ~ Dan Walsh

Nominated for best musician at last year's *BBC Folk Awards*, **Dan Walsh** combines "virtuoso playing and winning songwriting" (MORNING STAR). Describing what **Dan** does is no easy task but at the heart of it is British, Irish, and American folk music delivered with a healthy dose of funky grooves—all performed with his unique and dazzling take on clawhammer-style banjo helping to challenge all preconceptions about the instrument. Add to all that his poignant songs, astonishing musical departures, and lively humour, and the result is a truly memorable live show which has wowed

audiences across the world from intimate seated rooms to huge dancing crowds in festival fields. His new album *'Verging on the Perpendicular'* is **Dan's** fourth solo album and again has received much critical acclaim and is accompanied by a hectic touring schedule taking in the U.K., U.S., Canada, Australia, & New Zealand. Both solo and as a member of the award-winning *Urban Folk Quartet*, (as well as guest appearances on stage with *Imelda May*, *Joss Stone* and *the Levellers*) this unique and eclectic musician has stunned audiences across the world.



## September 17 ~ Paradise Street



**Paradise Street** is **Peet Vuur** (acoustic guitar), **Brad Hawkes** (percussive drums), and **Ron Ogden** (solid bass), with tight vocal harmonies that combine to become this fun, dynamic acoustic roots trio. Together they share their love of music, songwriting and performance with a joyful synergy made from a sweet mix of memories, originals, and a few covers you may never have heard before.

**Peet Vuur** (yes, he is Dutch) has been performing for over 30 years. **Peet's** warmth and humour shine brightest when he's singing his heart out with guitar in hand.

**Brad Hawkes** began playing a drum kit in 1964

and in the early '70s started playing congas in coffee houses. **Brad** has specialised in percussion, playing instruments including a stringed flamenco cajon.

Born and raised in Victoria, **Ron Ogden** had his first public performance at the young age of five. **Ron** loves all kinds of music and over the years has performed solo, in duos, trios, and bands. He feels very fortunate to be playing in **Paradise Street** with **Peet** and **Brad**.

## September 24 ~ JUGBANDITS!

**JUGBANDITS**—**Colleen Talson**, **Victor Talson**, **John Hewson** and **Graeme Card**—are a band. All are musicians. Particularly **John**. The newest of their number, 4, **John** comes with guitar, mandolin, trombone, cahon, harmonica, and voice. He is only allowed to play one instrument at a time. He was a band teacher, and now teaches Jug.

**Colleen** (voice, ukes, washboard, tap shoes and plank) is a female singer with a big heart. She brings to the band a flair for language, speaking primarily English, Spanish, and cockatoo. **Victor** (bass, dobro's, et al.) is tallest in intellect, with

snow on his peak and a background in everything. **Graeme** (B.A. Magna Floribunda) projects an image as a guitarist when you first talk to him, but he's really a kazoo player at heart and seeks to widen the acceptance of this complex instrument among the instrumentally deprived. His voice, when he's using it, is likened to that of a bicycle going down hill.

Founded and living somewhere in Victoria, **JUGBANDITS** project a wildness found rarely outside petting zoos and are unlike any band you have seen this morning.




## Victoria Folk Music Society

The Victoria Folk Music Society returns to Camp Pringle on the peaceful shores of Shawnigan Lake for a cozy Autumn Retreat. The days and evenings will be filled with jamming, song circles, and conversation—join us for a relaxing, informal weekend of sharing music with friends both old and new! There will be workshops to stretch your musical skills and repertoire. You can volunteer to lead a workshop, or moderate a jam session or song circle (Please indicate on the form below if you'd like to be a leader/moderator and we'll contact you). There will also be a concert that you can participate in on Saturday night.

Accommodations are various sized shared rooms in heated lodges with shared bathrooms and hot showers. The bunks come equipped with a foam mattress, but you will need to bring your own bedding, towels, and personal necessities. Spaces are first-come, first-served as you arrive. The Retreat begins Friday at 1:00 pm. (please don't arrive earlier). Good meals will be provided by the camp chef from Friday dinner to Sunday lunch. The Retreat ends Sunday afternoon following lunch and cleanup. You may also bring snacks for yourself and to share at the Saturday night concert, but the camp requires that there be no nuts in any of these. As with the Folk Club itself, this is a volunteer-run event, and everyone is asked to pitch in on various activities (cleanup, etc.); sign up for a volunteer job when you get there. However, good news again this year! Dishwashing will be done by the camp staff so you'll have more free time to enjoy yourself.
